CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION:

The Right to Information Act, 2005 was enacted in the Indian Parliament. The Act came into force on 12th October 2005 (120th day of its enactment on 15th June 2005). The Act extends to the whole of India except the State of Jammu and Kashmir. However, certain provisions of the Act pertaining to obligations of public authorities, designating Public Information Officers/Assistant Public Information Officers, Constitution of Central Information Commission/State Information Commission and powers to make rules under the Act came into force with immediate effect i.e. from 15th June'2005. The Act has a comprehensive reach and covers a wide spectrum of bodies like the Central Government, State Government, Panchayat Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies, other bodies established, constituted, owned, controlled or substantially financed by governments including non-governmental organizations (N.G.O). Access to information under this Act is extensive with minimum exemptions which are also subject to strict safeguards.

The main objective of the RTI Act 2005 is to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority in the country and to reduce corruption. The Act mandates a legal institutional frame work for setting out a practical regime of Right to Information for every citizen to secure access to information held by or under the control of public authority.

It prescribes mandatory disclosure of certain information to citizens and designation of State Public Information Officers (SPIO) in all public authorities to attend to request from citizens for information which will have to be supplied within the stipulated time. It provides for appeal to designated appellate officers against the decision of PIOs in case the information sought for has not been supplied. It also mandates the constitution of Central Information Commission and the State Information Commission to inquire into complaints, hear second appeals and be the watch dog of the implementation of the Act.

To provide right to information leading to an informed, enlightened and empowered citizens, government decision making process will have to be in the public domain and thereby provides deeper roots for democratic, open and participatory governance.

Most of the democratic societies all over the world have incorporated this right in their respective legal system.

Even in the Indian perspective, Article 19 (chapter III) of the constitution of India guarantees to all its citizens among other things, Fundamental Rights to freedom of Speech and expression. The Right to information as a Fundamental Right, flowing out from Article 19, (1) (A) of the constitution is now well settled and an accepted fact. Over the years, the Supreme Court has constantly ruled in favour of the citizen's right to know.

CHAPTER 2

A brief About Arunachal Pradesh Information Commission:

The Right to Information Act'2005 came into force in Arunachal Pradesh along with the rest of the country on 12th October 2005 after 120 days of its enactment. As per the provisions of this Act, State Public Information Officers (SPIO) and State Assistant Public Information Officers (SAPIO) were appointed by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh with separate notifications. In pursuance to the proviso of Clause 3, Section 15 of the Right to Information Act, a selection committee was constituted for the appointment of State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners. On 13/10/2006, Arunachal Pradesh Information Commission (APIC) was constituted and appointed Shri Nyodek Yonggam as the State Chief Information Commissioner and Shri Bani Danggen, Habung Payeng and Nipo Nabam as State Information Commissioners. They were administered the oath of office by His Excellency the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh on 19/10/2006.

Further a fresh selection committee was constituted in proviso of Clause (3) of Section 15 of the Right to Information Act 2005 in a separate notification dated 18th Oct'2007 and Shri Toko Anil was appointed as State Information Commissioner on 15/11/07. He was administered the oath of office by State Chief Information Commissioner, Arunachal Pradesh, on behalf of His Excellency the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh on 03/12/2007.

Due to new establishment, the Commission took sometime to start its functioning. The Commission has started functioning after getting office accommodation at Secretariat Annexe buildings in the first week of December'2006 with office functionaries provided by the State Government. The Commission, thereafter, entertained complains and appeals and initiated proceedings to disposed them off. It has also started monitoring the implementation of RTI Act and issued necessary instructions to various departments to comply with the provisions of RTI Act. The Commission is looking forward to educate the public and officials for proper implementation of RTI Act with the help of the State government.

COMMISSION'S ROLE ON THE IMPLEMENTING RTI ACT :- The Section 18 of the Act prescribes that Information Commission shall receive and enquire into a complaint from any person in respect of any matter relating to requesting or obtaining access to the records under the Act. It also empowers the Commission, during the enquiry of any complaint under the Act, to examine any record to which this Act applies under the control of public authority and no such record may be with held on any ground.

Section 19 mandates that the decision of the State Information Commission shall be binding. Further, the Information Commission, while deciding appeals can require a public authority to take any such steps as may be necessary to secure compliance with the provisions of the Act. Section 19, further mandates that while deciding appeals, the Information Commission is competent to impose any of the penalties under this Act.

Section 20, empowers the Commission to impose penalty, at the time of deciding any complaint or appeal if it is of the opinion that the SPIO has without any reasonable cause refused to receive an application for information or has not furnished the information within the time specified under Sub-Section (1) of Section 7 or malafiedly denied the request for information or knowingly given incorrect, incomplete or misleading information or destroyed information which was the subject of the request or obstructed in any manner in furnishing the information, it shall impose a penalty of Rs. 250/- each day till application is received or information is furnished. However, the total amount of such penalty shall not exceed Rs. 25000/-. Under section 23 of the Act no court shall entertain any suit, application or order proceedings in respect of any order made under this Act, and no such order shall be called in question otherwise than by way of an appeal under this Act.

Section 25, clause 3 (g) mandates that the State Information Commission shall state the recommendation in respect of the particular public authority, for development, improvement, modernization, reform or amendments to this Act or other legislations or common law or any other matters relevant for operationalising the Right to access to information.

The various provisions relating to Information Commission under the RTI Act 2005 place an onerous responsibility on the Commission towards the establishment of a practical regime of Right to Information for citizens and promotion of transparency and accountability in the working of public authorities in the State.

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY THE COMMISSION DURING THE REPORTING PERIOD

The Arunachal Pradesh Information Commission has been taking a proactive role-vis-à-vis- the state administration in pursuing the implementation of RTI Act 2005 at all levels. Towards this pursuit, the State Information Commissioners had visited some districts in the state and had interactions and meetings with the PIOs/APIOs, Appellate officers, numbers of NGOs and common citizens. The Commission has also held meetings with the Hon'ble Chief Minister, the Chief Secretary and other Commissioners and Secretaries on implementation of RTI Act in the state. The State Information Commissioners also attended Central Information Commissioners, State Chief Information Commissioners and State Information Commissioners conference in New Delhi held on 17/10/07. Further the State Information Commissioners visited a few States to study the functioning of State Information Commissions and the implementation of the RTI Act.

CHAPTER 3

IMPLEMENTATION OF RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT 2005 IN ARUNACHAL
PRADESH

1. RULES FRAMED UNDER THE RTI ACT 2005:-

(A) For smooth and effective implementation of the provisions of the RTI Act the Arunachal Pradesh State Government has framed the Arunachal Pradesh Right to Information Rules 2005 and notified it vide No.OM-43/2003 dated 15/09/2005. And subsequently made two amendments vide notification No.OM-73/2005 dated 15/05/2006 and 01/05/2007.

(B) Under Section 27 (2) (e) of the RTI Act 2005 the Arunachal Pradesh Information Commission (Appeal Procedure) Rules, 2005 has been notified on 24/11/2005.

2. SUO-MOTO DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION:- Section 4 of the RTI Act 2005, provides for pro active disclosure of information by the public authorities within 120 days from enactment of this Act. So far the progress of this provision in the State is not found satisfactory. The Commission is in constant touch with the public authorities to comply with these statutory provisions.

3. APPOINTMENT OF STATE INFORMATION OFFICERS:- Under Section 5 (1) every public authority shall within 100 days from the enactment of this Act designate the required number of officers in the administrative units under it as State Public Information Officers so as to provide information under the provision of this Act and Under Section 5 (2) the Public authorities shall designate within 100 days of enactment of this Act, the SAPIO at each sub-division centre or other sub-district level functioning under their control so as to receive the applications and forward the same to the SPIO or Appellate authority.

In compliance with the above provisions of the Act appointment of Information Officers have been made in the state as under.

- (a) PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER:- 363 PIOs have been appointed covering all public authorities and Autonomous bodies etc all over the State. Detail list Tabulated in Annexure-I.
- (b) ASSISTANT PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER (APIO):- All the Circle and Sub Divisional level officers of all the departments have been appointed as APIOs in the State.

- (c) FIRST APPELLATE OFFICER:- All the officers senior in rank to the PIOs in a given public authority have been appointed as Appellate Officers to hear appeals of citizens who are aggrieved of the decision/action of the PIOs regarding.
4. DISPOSAL OF INFORMATION REQUEST BY PIOs : Out of 363 designated PIOs as reflected in the Annexure-I,86 PIOs have submitted their reports so far, in which 555 numbers of request have been disposed off. A sum total of Rs 36566/- have been collected as fees and charges. Details tabulated in Annexure- II. Reports have not been furnished by the rest 277 PIOs.

CHAPTER 4

Commission's Observation and Recommendations :

1. It has been observed that the implementation of the provision pertaining to disclosure as mentioned U/S 4 (1) (b) of the RTI Act has not been satisfactory. The State Government should therefore, take necessary steps to ensure the voluntary disclosure of information by the Public Authorities.
2. Designation of PIOs, APIOs and Appellant Authorities by various public authorities U/S 5 and 19 of the Act is satisfactory to some extent. It is suggested that all the public authorities should appoint more PIOs, APIOs and Appellant Authorities as required.
3. It has been noticed that the lists of PIOs, APIOs, and Appellate Authorities have not been displayed in notice board by the Public Authorities. Therefore, the information seekers used to visit the office of the State Information Commission to know the names of PIOs and APIOs for filling application and to obtain application forms under the Act. The Public Authorities should therefore, ensure that the complete details of the designated PIOs, APIOs, and Public Authorities are made available for information seekers.
4. The Commission observed that the Public Authorities are not submitting periodical returns and reports to the nodal department of the State Government and the State Information Commission. For this purpose, the Public Authorities must collect information in prescribed format from PIOs and APIOs located in various places of public offices and submit the return and reports in stipulated time.
5. Section 26 of the RTI Act, 2005 delegates responsibilities on the State Government for propagating various provisions of the Act among the Citizens. However not much have been done so far in this regard during the reporting period. It is the duty of the State Government to develop and organize educational programme to advance the understanding of the policy in particular for the disadvantaged Community as to how to exercise the rights contemplated under this Act. Adequate budget needs to be provided to the State Information Commission or Nodal department to conduct extensive educational programme for the information seekers and training programme for information givers i.e. PIOs and public Authorities. During the financial year 2007-08 the ATI and SIRD had organized State level Training of trainers programmes on 'Capacity Building for Access to Information' under the financial Assistance of Department of Personnel and Training (DOPT), Govt. of India under

UNDP's project at Naharlagun on 12th October'2007 where a few Appellant Authorities and PIOs of two districts, viz – West Kameng and Lohit were given training on RTI Act'2005. The State Govt. is therefore, requested to provide funds to ATI, SIRD, NGOs and the State Information Commission to enable them to organize educational programmes on RTI Act'2005 at various levels.

6. The PIOs have additional responsibilities and duties to carry out the implementation of the RTI Act, apart from their normal official works. Therefore, it is necessary to provide them with additional infrastructure and extra remuneration.
7. The Commission observed that the State Information Commission should have financial autonomy at par with other states in the country so that the Commission need not go to the Finance department or the concerned administrative department for fund. Fund is also needed to meet administrative expenditure like providing brochures, photo copies and expenditure for proactive display of information. It is therefore, suggested that the State Government should provide financial support to the Commission in the form of Grants-in-aid with charged budget.
8. So far some officials in the Commission including the Registrar-cum-Secretary are working in addition to their portfolios in other department as step gap arrangement. In such a situation officer is unable to do justice in both the department which hampers in normal working process. On the other hand staff in the Commission is also posted from the general administration. Due to no direct administrative control on the staff by the Commission, the normal working process is adversely hampered. It is recommended that the post of all necessary staff be created immediately so that staffs could work and devote for the Commission's duty efficiently.
9. Considering the autonomous status of the Commission under the Act, the State Information Commission should be allowed to have autonomy in matters related to creation of posts and recruitment of the staffs and officials as per section 16 (6) the Act.
10. The Commission has observed that proper terms and conditions of services of State Chief Information Commissioner and State Information Commissioners have not yet been properly maintained by the state Government as per section 16 (5) of RTI Act, 2005. It is an established fact that for anybody in the public service having no such proper terms and conditions of service would face difficulty to maintain their true status in carrying out their duties and responsibilities. Therefore, the State Government is suggested to take appropriate steps in this connection in the line of other states.

Further, order of precedence of the State Chief Information Commissioner and the State Information Commissioners may also be specified.

11. The office accommodation provided for the Commission in the secretariat Annexe is not enough to accommodate its Commissioners, officers and staff. At present 2 & half block is allotted to the Commission in which only State Chief Information Commissioner and four Commissioners and its personnel staff could be accommodated. Commission needs office chamber for Registrar-cum-Secretary, Deputy Registrar, Asstt. Registrar, Accounts officer and other staffs. It is also necessary to have a separate court room, conference room and library for the Commission. At present the Registrar, DDO and Account officer are functioning from their own office and they have been entrusted to perform the duty of the Commission in addition to their own duties. Therefore, it is suggested that one more block in the secretariat annex be allotted to the Commission until its own infrastructure is created for Commission. Keeping in view the Commission's requirement of infrastructure in near future due to increase volume of activities and responses on RTI implementation from the public. It is suggested that the Commission be allotted a plot of land in a central location and keep fund provision for construction of Commission building.
12. Residential accommodation is also not provided to some Commissioners so far even after more than a year has been passed. It is learnt that the suitable accommodation could not be provided due to paucity of government accommodation. Therefore, State government is requested to provide reasonable house rent to those who has not been provided with such residential accommodation as per their rank and status. In some states the Commissioners are paid Rs. 16,000/- per month in lieu of government accommodation.
13. The State Information Commissioners are also not provided staff car of its own. Old cars from the Secretariat pool are provided to the Commissioners on temporary basis. The vehicles are to be repaired frequently and are not fit to go on tour. The Commission has proposed either to sanction for procurement of new vehicles or provide Rs. 18,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Thousand) only per month in lieu of staff car as practiced in some states. Paying Rs. 18,000/- per month in lieu of staff car will be more economical as it includes fuel and driver salary except journey beyond 30 kms from the headquarters. It is recommended for appropriate action.
