**ORDER**

Whereas, an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 has been received from Shri Shoney Pertin, President Siang Rights Forum(SRF), Airfield Pasighat, Ward No-4, Po/Ps-Pasighat, East Siang District, for non-furnishing of information, by Shri Gonong Pertin, PIO-cum-EE(WRD), Pasighat Division, East Siang District ,Arunachal Pradesh, as sought, by the Appellants under section 6(1) of RTI Act, 2005 on 12/02/2020.

Whereas, the 1<sup>st</sup> hearing was held through online video / audio conference on 6<sup>th</sup> October'2020. Shri Gonong Pertin, PIO-cum-EE(WRD), Pasighat Division, East Siang District ,Arunachal Pradesh and the Appellant Shri Shoney Pertin appeared during the hearing through video conferencing. The Appellant informed the Commission that the PIO has not furnished information for the Sl.no. 3, i.e. Detail of LOC copy received in respect of the project, Sl.no. 8, i.e. Furnish the name of two National newspapers in which tender notification and Sl.no. 10, i.e. Furnish the copy of daily progress report of the project. For the information Sl.no. 7, the PIO has furnished only one local newspaper (The Arunachal Times), whereas two local newspapers were sought.

The PIO informed the Commission that for Sl.no.3, they do not have LOC for the project, for Sl.no. 8, no record has been maintained, for Sl.no. 10, the daily progress report of the project is not being maintained. However, the PIO informed that monthly progress report is maintained, if the Appellant require he may apply a fresh application. For Sl.no. 7, the PIO informed that the DIPR was asked to publish in two local newspapers but in record only one local paper is available and the same has been furnished to the Appellant.
