ORDER

Whereas, an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 has been received from Shri Amin Danggen, Village-Simong, PO/PS Yingkiong, Upper Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh, for non-furnishing of information, by Dr. D.Bagra, PIO-cum-DMO, Upper Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh, as sought, by the Appellant under section 6(1) of RTI Act, 2005 on 18/07/2019.

Whereas, the rescheduled 1st hearing was held on 17th March' 2020. Dr. D.Bagra, PIO-cum-DMO, Upper Siang District, was present during the hearing. The appellant Shri Amin Danggen vide letter No. NIL Dated 16/03/2020 informed the Commission that he is unable to attend the hearing. Further, the Appellant informed that the PIO has not furnished any information sought by him. The PIO informed the Commission that some information sought by the Appellant are not available in his office and also not under the purview of his office. However, information have been collected and furnished to the Appellant. The Appellant did not complain for any shortages of the information.

Whereas, the Commission giving reasonable opportunity to the Appellant decided to give another date of hearing.

Whereas, the 2nd hearing was held through Video / Audio Conferencing on 21st April'2020. Dr. D.Bagra, PIO-cum-DMO, Upper Siang District, and Appellant Shri Amin Danggen attended the hearing through audio conference as Upper Siang District has no good network connectivity for video conference. The PIO informed the Commission that 45 (forty five) pages of information as sought by the Appellant have been furnished to the Appellant. The Appellant informed the Commission that some information are not furnished by the PIO. The Appellant also sent a letter No. NIL Dated 21st April, 2020 stating the same.
