ORDER

The appeal has been received from Smti Rani Jomoh Tawe, appellant, A-Sector, Naharlagun, Ward No.24, District Papumpare, Arunachal Pradesh under section 19(3) of RTI Act 2005, for non furnishing of information under sub-section(1) of section 6 of RTI Act by the PIO-cum-ADC, Shri Talom Dupak, ADC, Capital Complex, DC's, Office, Capital Complex, Itanagar, District Papumpare, A.P.

Having received the appeal the commission felt it imperative to hear the appeal as reasonable opportunity to PIO and the information seeker in the open court proceeding.

The first hearing was held on 05.03.20. During the hearing PIO was represented by one Shri Tam Kaya, DASO APIO, O/o DC, Capital Complex, Itanagar and appellant Smti, Rani Jamoh Tawe were present.

Heard APIO and appellant both. In the hearing APIO Shri Tam Kaya informed that all the related information has been furnished to the appellant. But appellant stated that she was not satisfied with the information as all the documents were incorrect and misleading information. Therefore, the APIO has been directed to provide the correct and complete information to the appellant on or before the next hearing being fixed on 13.03.20. The appellant has been asked to verify and cross-check the documents as desired by her and informed the commission invariably whether she is satisfied or not on the information furnished by representative of PIO on or before next hearing.

In the third hearing which was held on 16.03.20, wherein both the appellant and APIO on behalf of PIO were present. Heard both parties, when asked to the APIO as to whether he had complied the order passed on dated 13.03.20. In reply, the APIO stated that all the required information has been provided to appellant and she is satisfied over the information.

On the other hand, the appellant submitted application dated 16.03.20, stating that she has received all the required information from PIO and prayed for closer of the appeal APIC No 41/2020 forthwith.

Therefore, in view of above circumstances the commission observed that further hearing is not necessary and deemed it fit to dispose of the instant case.

Hence, the appeal APIC NO. 41/2020 dtd 11..12.19 stands disposed of today the 16th March 2020 copy of this order be forwarded to the concerned PIO and appellant accordingly.
